

COVID-19 has changed all our lives in what seems like the blink of an eye. At Pan Am Clinic, the safety and care of our patients and staff are a top priority. We are still open and continuing to care for patients with bone, joint, and muscle problems as we always have. We are implementing all PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTIVES to keep you and your families safe.

Here are some highlights of what we are doing:

- Upon entry, all patients are requested to use hand sanitizer. Patients will then be asked a set of screening questions to determine their risk of infection with COVID-19. If a patient is deemed a risk, they will be provided a mask and, if their condition isn't urgent, may be redirected to a COVID-19 testing site in the community before they can receive treatment at our clinic.
- Individuals that are at risk, but require immediate care, are placed in isolation and seen by one of our physicians for treatment.
- Visitors are restricted from entering except where absolutely necessary.
- We have adjusted our waiting rooms to allow for social distancing.
- Staff wear personal protective equipment in accordance with public health recommendations.
- We have increased frequency of cleaning and disinfection throughout the facility.
